Based on his qualifying test score, Freidin was one of ten selected nationally to compete for \$10,000 in the Who Wants to be a Mathematician contest. The contest took place January 14 at the annual Joint Mathematics Meetings in San Francisco, attended by over 6,000 mathematicians. Freidin placed sixth and won \$500, some books, and \$500 for GBN's Math Team.
