- **Re:** Overnight Student Trip for Glenbrook North Students to Attend the IHSA Boys Bowling State Tournament in Fairview Heights, Illinois

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education ratify the Superintendent's authorization for an overnight trip for Glenbrook North students to attend the IHSA Boys Bowling State Competition from Thursday, January 26, 2023, through Saturday, January 28, 2023, in Fairview Heights, Illinois.

Background

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Mr. Catalano shared in his memo, eight Glenbrook North students qualified for the IHSA State Tournament. Due to the timing of this trip, Dr. Johns previously approved this trip under the provision of Board Policy 7230, which states, "The Superintendent has authority to approve certain overnight trips in extenuating circumstances (e.g., IHSA qualifying state series), subject to Board ratification. We request that the Board of Education ratify the trip from Thursday, January 26, 2023, through Saturday, January 28, 2023, in Fairview Heights, Illinois.
