Re: School Improvement Late Arrival Days

Recommendation

Increase from 14 school improvement late arrival days to 22 to facilitate professional development and staff work on school improvement goals. Adjust the current school improvement late arrival time to 9:30 AM allowing for increased instructional time on these days. The school improvement late arrival days would be scheduled consistently on Wednesdays, aligning with District 34, which currently has a late arrival schedule every Wednesday for students.

Background

The district instituted school improvement late arrival days in the 1994-1995 school year in response to the research on school start-time and student well-being in order to accommodate the need for faculty collaboration and professional development. Over the years, the district has increased the number of school improvement late arrival days from a monthly occurrence to 14 per year. These days have served as a valuable time for faculty and have met the goal of supporting our students' well-being by providing more equally important time to them.

What are the school district's interests as it relates to school improvement, late arrival time, faculty, and department meetings?

- Create a structure that allows faculty and department meetings with full participation without the competing priorities of after-school responsibilities and commitments. This will make Monday after school available for clubs and activities, which currently do not schedule meetings or activities on this day due to faculty and department meetings.
- Increase opportunities for systemic department curriculum collaboration between the two schools.
- Balancing the interests of student well-being, a positive staff climate, and instructional minutes to
 ensure a schedule allowing for the highest quality learning experience. This would be
 accomplished through a more frequent, predictable, and consistent schedule.
- Maintain the frequency of collaboration at all levels while increasing the fidelity of the experiences.

Proposed Schedule

Based on feedback from stakeholders, we recommend the revised schedule below with a 9:30 AM start time. This provides the least variance in instructional time between regular days and school improvement days.

The difference between our current schedule and the proposed schedule is 140 minutes over the course of an entire school year with the addition of eight school improvement late arrival days.

Feedback Process

The following stakeholder groups reviewed this proposal and offered feedback on multiple occasions over the past several months: the District 225 Cabinet, GEA representatives, Instructional Leadership and Building Administrative Teams, faculty, students, and parents.
