Re: Overnight Student Trip for Glenbrook South Students to Attend the IHSA Swimming and Diving

State Competition in Westmont, Illinois

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education ratify the Superintendent's authorization for an overnight trip for Glenbrook South students to attend the Overnight Student Trip for Glenbrook South Students to Attend the IHSA Swimming and Diving State Competition from Thursday, November 10, 2022, through Saturday, November 12, 2022, in Westmont, Illinois.

#### **Background**

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Ms. Laura Duffy shared in her memo, two students from Glenbrook South qualified for the swimming and diving IHSA state tournament this month. Due to the timing of this trip, Dr. Johns previously approved this trip under the provision of Board Policy 7230, which states, "The Superintendent has authority to approve certain overnight trips in extenuating circumstances (e.g., IHSA qualifying state series), subject to Board ratification. We request that the Board of Education ratify the trip from Thursday, November 10, 2022, through Saturday, November 12, 2022, in Westmont, Illinois.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

**Memo:** This is a request for an overnight trip to compete at the Illinois High School Association Swimming and Diving State Competition to be held at the FMC Natatorium in Westmont, IL on Friday, November 11 and Saturday, November 12, 2022. I have two divers, senior Jacki Stadler and junior Sydney Hall, who qualified for this competition on Saturday. Jacki qualified by winning the sectional diving event and Sydney qualified by having one of the top 32 scores in the state. Currently, Jacki is the number one seed in the state and Sydney is ranked 15th. Our goal is to stay loose, dive well, have fun, and qualify two divers to the state finals. Jacki's goal is to improve upon her 4th place performance from last year, and Sydney would like to make the finals.
