Re: Overnight Student Trip for Glenbrook North and South Students to Attend the Illinois Music

Education Association All-State Conference in Peoria, Illinois

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve an overnight trip for Glenbrook North and South students to attend the Illinois Music Education Association All-State Conference from Wednesday, January 25, 2023, through Saturday, January 28, 2023, in Peoria, Illinois.

## **Background**

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Ms. Cody Halberstadt and Mr. Chad Davison shared in their memo, music students across the state of Illinois each year audition for and participate in regional performance festivals. The top performing students in each region are then selected to move forward to State level performance ensembles. Selection to the Illinois All-State Conference is among the highest honors that a high school musician may earn and is achieved through a highly competitive audition process, with over 10,000 students across the state auditioning annually. This year, we are excited to share that five students from Glenbrook North and four students from Glenbrook South were selected to participate in an all-state ensemble or composition track at the January music educators conference.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

**Re:** Illinois Music Education Association All-State Overnight Trip

Dear Dr. Georges and Mr. Markey,

Each year, music students across the state of Illinois audition and participate in regional performance festivals and the top performing students in each region are then selected to move forward to State level performance ensembles. Selection to the Illinois All-State Conference is among the highest honors that a high school musician may earn and is accomplished through a highly competitive audition process, with over 10,000 students across the state auditioning annually. Glenbrook North and Glenbrook South High Schools are proud to share that seven band and choir students were selected to perform in the All-State Bands, Choirs, and Vocal Jazz Ensembles. Additionally, two students from Glenbrook North High School were selected through rigorous adjudication to participate in the composition track during the All-State Conference. The students selected from GBN & GBS are:

We are requesting Board approval of an overnight trip for our students to accept this honor and participate in the Illinois Music Education Association's All-State Conference. The conference is held annually in Peoria, IL and will take place from Wednesday, January 25th through Saturday, January 28th, 2023. Students will leave after school on January 25th and will attend a performance by a Grammy-nominated vocal ensemble. Students will then participate in rehearsals throughout the day and evening on January 26th and 27th, culminating in All-State performances on January 27th and 28th. Students from GBN & GBS will be transported to



Peoria using a District 225 activity bus, driven by a District 225 staff member, and then are generally transported home by their parents/guardians. If a parent/guardian cannot transport a student home, the students can return on the activity bus. Student meals are purchased by the students on the trip at their own cost. There are multiple food options near each rehearsal location and students are recommended to bring approximately \$110 for meals. During the trip, faculty from GBN & GBS will chaperone students and engage in professional development opportunities, including attending PD sessions, performances, and open rehearsals. Faculty from both schools will include: Cody Halberstadt (GBS), Chad Davidson (GBN), Brian Boron (GBS), Dan Gregerman (GBS), Robert Shellard (GBS), Rachel Atlas (GBS/GBN), and Aaron Kaplan (GBN/GBS).
