- **Re:** Overnight Student Trip for the Glenbrook North Students to Attend the Snowball Overnight Retreat in East Troy, Wisconsin

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve an overnight trip for Glenbrook North students to attend the snowball overnight retreat from Thursday, November 17, 2022, through Saturday, November 19, 2022, in East Troy, Wisconsin.

Background

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Mr. Darin Sullivan shared in his memo, this trip provides an opportunity for up to 100 students, 20 student leaders, and 18 staff to attend the snowball overnight retreat at YMCA Camp Edwards in East Troy, Wisconsin. Operation Snowball is a club dedicated to promoting mental and emotional health, personal growth, and a sense of community among students and staff. Our annual three-day retreat serves as a kick-off event for the club's activities. For the past 12 years, this retreat has provided students with opportunities to learn more about themselves, connect with others, and discuss various topics important to their lives.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

Subject: Snowball Overnight Retreat

Operation Snowball is a club dedicated to promoting mental and emotional health, personal growth, and a sense of community among students and staff. Our annual three-day retreat serves as a kick-off event for the club's activities. For the past 12 years, this retreat has provided students with opportunities to learn more about themselves, connect with others, and discuss a wide variety of topics important to their lives. Please see the attached itinerary for further descriptions of the activities taking place throughout the retreat.

This year's retreat is projected to include up to 100 student participants in addition to 20 student leaders and up to 18 adult staff. Final numbers will be finalized after registration is complete on October 14th. Participants must complete an application to attend the retreat, and if over 100 students apply, attendees will be selected by lottery.

The Operation Snowball Directors (three students, three adult staff) will depart for Camp Edwards in East Troy, WI via a GBN activity bus on the morning of Thursday, November 17, 2022. All other attendees will travel to Camp Edwards via school bus after school that same day. All students and staff will return to GBN via school bus and activity bus on the afternoon of Saturday, November 19.

We will follow Board Policy 7230 for overnight travel for this trip. The students will pay all costs of the trip in one lump fee which will include travel, lodging, and meals at Camp Edwards as well as guest speakers a T-shirt and other general supplies. The cost per student will be \$140.00. In efforts to offer this to all students, a reduced price of \$70.00 for students who receive free and reduced meals/ supplies will be supplemented from our Operation Snowball Activity Account AN903740.
