- **Re:** Overnight Student Trip for the Glenbrook South Varisty Soccer Team to Attend a Tournament in Indianapolis

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve an overnight trip for the Glenbrook South varsity soccer team to attend a tournament from Friday, September 23, 2022 through Saturday, September 24, 2022 in Indianapolois, Indiana.

Background

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Mr. Reggie Lara shared in his memo, this trip plays an important role in team-building with a bonding experience, preparing our team for playoffs with challenging opponents we don't normally face in our area, and providing the players/parents with a memorable, unique experience. The Zionsville Classic is known as the most competitive soccer tournament in Indiana, with multiple state-ranked opponents participating. In addition, our Friday-night game versus Noblesville will also be an excellent opportunity for our program to compete against the former 3A state champion of Indiana and last year's #5-ranked team in the entire country.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

We receive no money from the school to finance this trip. This is 100% paid by students or covered in program fundraising efforts.

Transportation:

Students will take two D225 mini buses to Noblesville HS (Noblesville, IN) on September 23rd and a bus home from Zionsville HS (Zionsville, IN) on September 24th.

Hotel Accommodations:

Students/Coaches will stay at the Holiday Inn Express & Suites (6064 S Main St, Whitestown, IN 46075) for 1 night.

The price is as follows: Price per hotel room: \$170 2 players to a room: \$85 per player We will follow the policy of the Board of Education policy that specifies one student per bed.

Parents will pay Glenbrook South HS through the bookstore. Glenbrook South will collect money that will be submitted to the Boys Soccer Account. Staff travel will be paid through fundraising dollars in our Student Activities Account. The \$500 includes staff meals and hotel overnight for the 4 coaches supervising the trip which is included in the per student cost.

We anticipate being able to offset a large portion of the amount owed by each student through the soccer program's fundraising efforts. I estimate that students will owe closer to \$60 rather than \$145.83 as calculated in the attached cost allocation worksheet.

Safety Measures:

If there is an issue with a student getting sick, parents will be required to pick up their child and take them home.

Parents will be required to sign travel waivers from D225. <u>Waiver</u>
