**Re:** Overnight Student Trip for Glenbrook North ARML Regional Contest

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education authorize the overnight trip for Glenbrook North students to attend the American Regions Math League (ARML) Competition held in Iowa City, Iowa, from Thursday, June 2, 2022, through Saturday, June 4, 2022, as presented.

#### **Background**

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

Earlier this month, we received a request from Chicago Area All-Star Math Team (CAASMT) sponsor, Mr. Steve Goodman, requesting approval for students to attend the American Regions Math League (ARML) competition to be held at the University of Iowa (Iowa City) from Thursday, June 2, 2022, through Saturday, June 4, 2022. Six students at Glenbrook North have qualified for this opportunity.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

Dear Mr. Markey,

Every year, the ChicagoARML organization forms the Chicago Area All-Star Math Teams (CAASMT) to compete nationally at the American Regions Math League (ARML) competition. Regional teams from across the country compete the first weekend in June for a national championship. Teams from the Midwest will compete at the University of Iowa the weekend of June 3-4, 2022.

This year, six Glenbrook North students have qualified for the Chicago teams. These students will practice with their CAASMT teammates five times before traveling together via bus to Iowa and spending the weekend there competing. We will stay in University of Iowa dormitories, with one student to a bed.

I am one of the coaches of ChicagoARML and will also be traveling to chaperone and to be the moderator/emcee of the Iowa site.

ChicagoARML charges an all-inclusive fee of \$425 for students and \$400 for coaches to cover transportation, lodging, registration, and food. The trip departs on Thursday night, June 2, and returns Saturday night. The \$425 breakdown for students is approximately divided as

Housing \$180 Transportation \$165 Registration \$40 Food \$40

The coach fee of \$400 is similar except no registration for the contest and an extra charge for housing for a single room. Please note the food expense is well within the standard meal allotment for staff on trips.

I am including a field-trip request form, a cost worksheet, and an itinerary with this letter for presentation to the superintendent and board. I would be appreciative of trip approval and district payment from the math team's budget for all of the expenses for me, plus 75% of transportation and lodging and 100% of registration for each student.
