- **Re:** Overnight Student Trip for the Glenbrook North Varsity Lacrosse Team to Participate in a Tournament in Cincinnati, Ohio

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve an overnight trip for the Glenbrook North Varsity lacrosse team to participate in a tournament from Friday, March 31, 2023, through Saturday, April 1, 2023, in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Background

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

As Mr. Catlano shares in his memo, the Glenbrook North varsity lacrosse team has been invited to play in a series of games in Cincinnati, Ohio. They will play on Friday, March 31, 2023, and Saturday, April 1, 2023. The team will compete in a series of games with Sycamore and Elder High School.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials. Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.
