Re: Overnight Trip for Glenbrook South Students to Participate in the Illinois Science Olympiad State

Competition in Urbana-Champaign, Illinois

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve an overnight trip for Glenbrook South students to participate in the Illinois Science Olympiad State Competition from Friday, April 21, 2023, through Saturday, April 22, 2023, in Urbana-Champaign, Illinois.

Background

Board Policy 7230 authorizes student trips that offer valuable experiences for students outside the school district's boundaries. The policy was recently revised in February 2022 to define conditions and parameters based on the type of trip and the consideration process for all requests. The principal first approves all day and overnight trips, and any trip requiring an overnight stay must also be approved by the superintendent and the Board of Education.

Before being presented to the Board for consideration, the Associate Principal for Administrative Services works with the Business Services department to ensure that each trip proposal adheres to all conditions and parameters defined in Board Policy. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Classification of the trip;
- Determination of the approval process;
- Determination of financial responsibility and the process for collecting fees (if applicable);
- Travel insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Collection of a permission slip and verification of accident and health insurance coverage (if applicable);
- Lodging, meals, and transportation arrangements; and
- Registration requirements.

The Glenbrook South Science Olympiad Team is planning to attend the Illinois Science Olympiad State Competition at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign from April 21-22, 2023. Students qualify for the State Competition by placing at the top of our Regional Competition. The purpose of the trip is for students to compete in the 23 Science Olympiad events, earn medals in their events, and possibly qualify for the National Competition. GBS Science Olympiad has attended the State Competition nearly every year for the past ten years. The State tournament has been virtual for the past two years, so students are excited to attend again in person and test their skills against the best science students in the state.

A detailed overview of the trip is provided in the attached materials.

Additionally, a summary of the trip's conditions and parameters is provided in Table 1.

The Glenbrook South Science Olympiad Team is planning to attend the Illinois Science Olympiad State Competition at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign from April 21-22, 2023. Students qualify for the State Competition by placing at the top of our Regional Competition.

The purpose of the trip is for students to compete in the 23 Science Olympiad events, earn medals in their events, and possibly qualify for the National Competition.

Students will be excused from their block 3 and 4 classes on Friday April 21st, so that they can eat lunch during 3a and then load the bus at 12pm. The bus will take us to the hotel where we will check in and drop off bags, then take us to campus so that students have time to explore the campus to find the locations of their different events. Students will eat dinner on campus and then the bus will return us to the hotel. Early on Saturday morning, we will check out and the bus will take us back to campus where students will spend the day competing in their events. An awards ceremony is held after events are completed. After awards (approximately 7pm) the bus will begin to drive us back to GBS, stopping about 30 minutes into the trip (this avoids congested campus food options) so that students can get dinner before the bus ride home. Students will bring their own money for dinner the first night, lunch on Saturday, and dinner on Saturday. Continental breakfast is included at the hotel.

GBS Science Olympiad has attended the State Competition nearly every year for the past ten years. While we try to raise some money through fundraising, the trip has been covered in the past because it is a State level competition.

The State tournament has been virtual for the past two years, so students are excited to once again attend in person and test their skills against the best science students in the state.
