Re: Class of 2024 Chromebook Purchase

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the purchase of 1,400 Lenovo 500e Chromebooks with the Google Chrome Management License from Computer Drive at a cost of \$421,750.

Background

For the past five years, the District has selected the Lenovo Chromebook for the 1:1 initiative. Recently we have utilized the Lenovo 500e Chromebook, which is extremely durable and features spill-proof keyboards and touchpads, mechanically anchored keys, rubber bumpers around the LCD and base, Gorilla Glass, reinforced ports, corners, and hinges. From a technical specification perspective, both devices include Intel Apollo Lake processors, 4GB of memory, 32GB of internal storage. It is recommended the District continue with the Lenovo 500e Chromebook.

Three vendors submitted a quote for the purchase of 1,400 Chromebooks and associated management licenses. The following is a summary of the result:

Chromebook Fee

The annual Chromebook fee is assessed to all students (up to a maximum of 4 years) for the use of a Chromebook during their high school career. After making the designated amount of payments, the Chromebook becomes the property of the student.

In addition to ownership rights after three or years of payment (depending on the class), students are provided with a comprehensive insurance program at no additional cost. Information regarding coverage is indicated on the attached *Chromebook Rights and Responsibilities* document. Balance in the self-insurance reserve is \$104,381; of which approximately 60% is a result of the early Samsung devices when the district bought third party insurance coverage and, due to the high number and cost of claims, the insurance company paid the district to fix the devices in-house.

The cost of this program not reflected in the table above is the cost of the loaner and replacement pool. 100 devices are typically purchased each year to serve as a loaner and replacement pool. The total cost for the 2020-21 fiscal year is \$27,800 which equates to \$5.35/student per year.
