

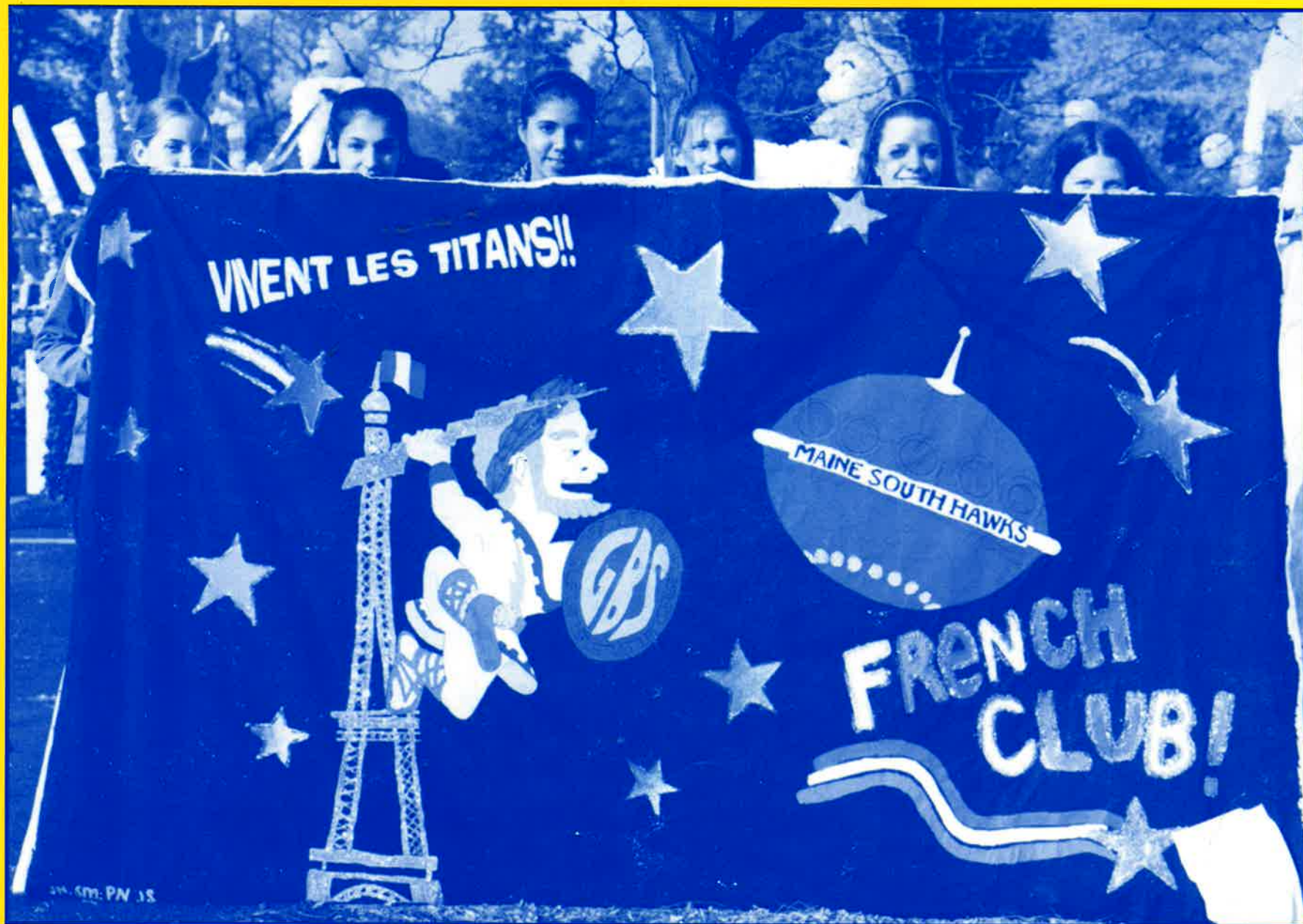

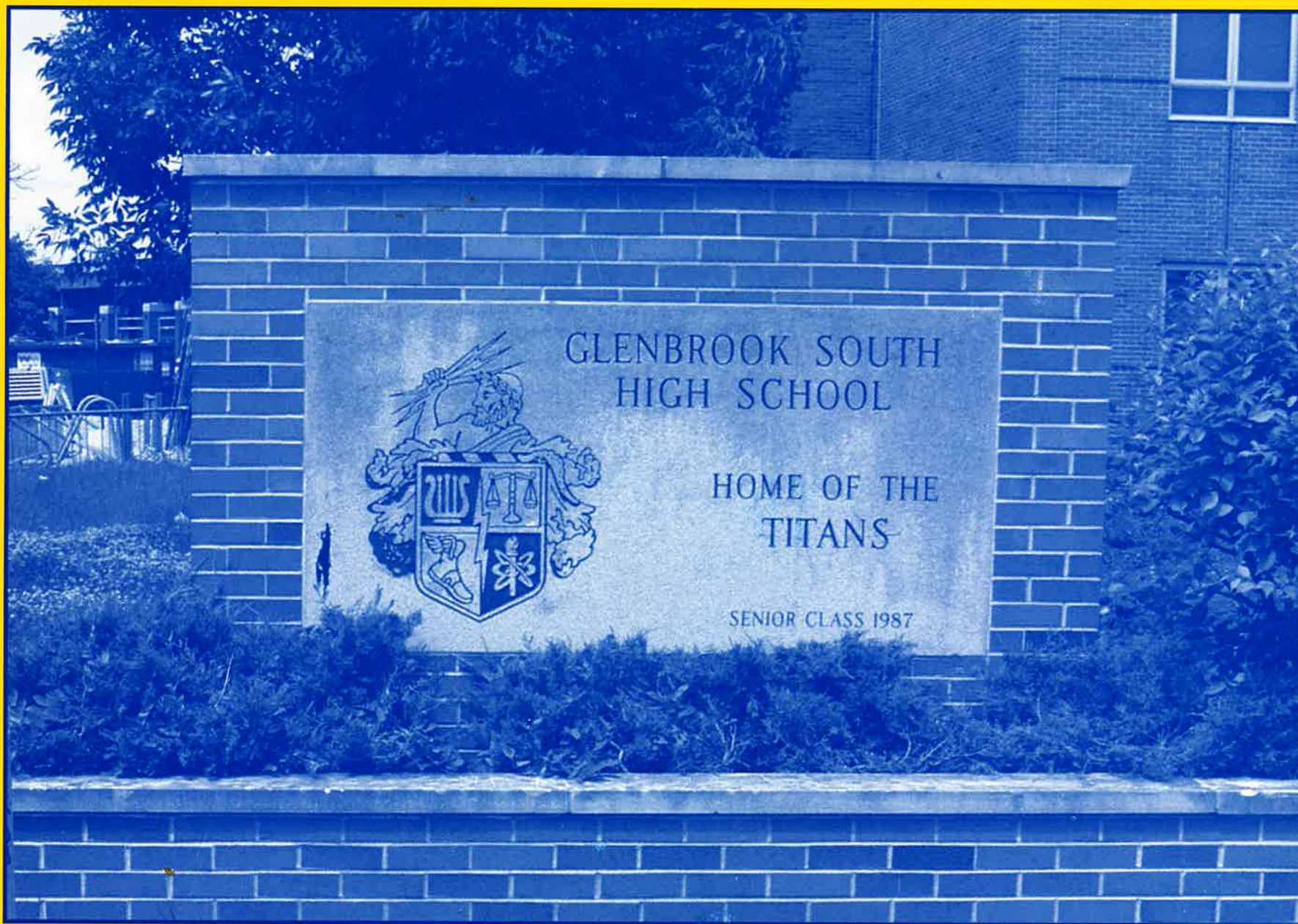

## GBS Students Brighten Holidays With Giving

## Final Evaluations Are Scheduled for January 18-20.

Final evaluations account for 20% of the semester grade; the nine week grades each account for 40%. Nearly all classes, except physical education, have final evaluations. Freshman homeroom study skills has a final that is given before the scheduled evaluation period.

Students are required to be in the building only when they have a final evaluation scheduled. For example, if your student has 11-13 physical education, 14-16 lunch and 17-19 homeroom, he would not be required to be in school on Wednesday, January 19 because he would have no scheduled final evaluations. Students may be in the building for quiet study in the IMC and resource centers.

Parents can help students organize a study plan for their finals. Generally students need to begin studying for their final evaluations a week or more in advance of the evaluation. Often teachers will give study guides that students can use as a basis for their preparation. Buses run as usual each morning of finals. There are early buses at 11:30 AM and also at 1:45 PM to take students home after their finals. The after school activities/athletics buses run at 4:15.

## Board Takes Action on Enrollment Issue

Following several months of deliberation, the Glenbrook Board of Education took the following action at the Dec. 12 Board meeting:

**Future Voluntary Transfer:** Voluntary transfer of students from the GBS attendance area to the GBN attendance area will be used to avert overcrowding at GBS in the future. Based upon the current projections, the voluntary program will start with the 1999-2000 school year.

**Addition to GBS:** An addition should be made to GBS as soon as possible to increase the capacity of the school to 2450 students. The facility committee should submit the final plan to the Board for final approval. Remodeling and rearranging space at GBN should begin as soon as possible.

**Rescind Policy:** The 1978 policy JBCCB should be rescinded and the administration is directed to draft a new policy taking the most recent information and motions into account.

## Final Evaluations

- Final exams count for 20% of the semester grade; the nine week grades each count for 40%.
- Nearly all classes, except physical education, have final exams.
- Students are required to be in the building only when they have a final exam scheduled (if they have no exams scheduled on a particular day, they do not have to come to school).
- When not taking exams, students may be in the building for quiet study in the IMC and resource centers.
- Buses will follow the usual AM pick up schedule. Buses depart GBS at 11:30 AM and 1:45 PM each exam day. Activity/athletics bus departs at 4:15.

## Dual Grades

Several years ago the Glenbrook schools began indicating two report card grades in certain subjects. One grade reflects a student's performance in the course content, and the second grade reflects the teacher's assessment of the student's writing in the same course. The writing grade is on a student's

permanent transcript only in English. In all other areas the grade is intended to simply inform you of your student's performance in writing. This information emphasizes the importance of writing as a critical life skill. We urge you to discuss writing grades, along with regular course grades, when you talk to your student, teachers or counselors.

## Scheduling Decision

The Scheduling Committee has recommended a schedule change for the 1997/98 school year. Teacher training and implementation strategies will be worked out during the 1996/97 school year. Three scheduling concepts have been defined, and the difficult work of selecting the appropriate schedule to meet the needs of Glenbrook students is underway. The overall goal is to improve the school day for students and enhance learning. A decision on the scheduling concept is planned for March. The three scheduling concepts are:

- **4X4 Intensive Schedule:** maximum of eight courses per year, four courses per day, a long block of time for each class. Each course meets every day for one to four nine-week terms.
- **A/B Alternating Block Schedule:** maximum of eight courses per year, four courses per day, a long block of time for each class. Most courses meet every other day for two semesters. Some elective courses meet every other day for one semester.
- **Block Scheduling Hybrid:** offers a customized schedule that utilizes the advantages of intensive and/or alternating block schedules.

## IGAP, ACT, State Scholars & Semifinalists

When statewide IGAP test results were published in November, the Chicago Tribune stated, "North Shore schools historically perform well on IGAP tests and 1997 was no exception . . . Students at Glenbrook South in Glenview rated in the top ten in three categories: 2nd in Writing, 8th in math, 9th in Social Studies.

The GBS ACT was in the top ten scores in the state and at the 96th percentile nationwide. Recently it was announced that 132 GBS students were named Illinois State Scholars, or 25% of the class, two and a half times the state average of 10%. State Scholars are selected based on ACT score and class rank. In September, 14 GBS students were named National Merit Semifinalists, based on PSAT scores.

## Demographic Briefing

At the Dec. 13 Board of Education meeting, the Demographic Trends and Enrollment Projections study, prepared by John D. Kasarda, Ph.D., was discussed. The report included School Districts 27, 28, 30, 31, 34 and 225. Highlights show:

- Increases in student populations in the elementary schools from the mid 80's to the present are attributable to a combination of new housing starts and housing turnover, as aging empty nesters have moved out.
- Birth rates have leveled off in both villages; future enrollment will not be fueled by births but by housing turnover to younger families.
- Due to the development of GNAS, the Village of Glenview and District 34 will experience the greatest growth in coming years.
- District 225 can expect between 100-167 students as a result of GNAS development.
- Enrollment at GBN is projected to remain consistent at around 2,000 for the next 15 years. Enrollment at GBS will increase to approximately 2,600 students over the next four to five years and remain fairly steady for the following ten years.

The Board of Education asked the district to explore the following options and report back to the Board in February:

- Retain or modify current boundaries to accommodate the neighborhood/community school concept. This would require revisiting the Facilities Master Plan for GBS to examine the impact (educational, classroom space, infrastructure) of accommodating up to approximately 2600 students at GBS.
- Study the impact of designating the anticipated 100-167 high school students from GNAS to attend GBN instead of GBS.

The Board requested that the district inform parents and developers at GNAS that although current boundaries are in the GBS attendance area, it is possible students might attend GBN.

The Board also asked the district to consider any programs that could be shifted to GBN that would free up additional space at GBS, as well as the impact of different schedules that could improve building capacity.

Following review of all data, it is still possible the Board will study further boundary changes. Parents will continue to be informed through the Connections newsletter, the Glenbrook Update on GBN and GBS TV, cable channels 26 & 27, and local press.
