Re: Reallocation of 2016-2017 Non-certified Staffing

After consultation with the building principals, I propose a reallocation of non-certified FTE for the 2016-17 school year.

This request reallocates the combined 1.57 FTE of two retiring Lab Manager positions to create a second Assistant Trainer position at GBN (0.92 FTE) and an additional part-time Special Education Department Assistant at GBS (0.39 FTE). After the proposed FTE reallocation, there will be a savings of 0.26 FTE remaining.

As requested by the Board of Education on the May 23, 2016, meeting, please review the cost analysis specific to the additional Assistant Athletic Trainer at GBN. This analysis demonstrates an overall estimated savings of \$40,855.
