DISCUSSION/ACTION: BOOKSTORE RECAP

Effective with the FY 12/13 school year, the district changed its outsourced bookstore vendor from Follett Higher Education Group (Follett) to Becks Bookstores (Becks). As a result of this transition, the district reduced its annual management fee from \$160,000 with Follett, to \$96,000 with Becks.

The transition with Becks is going very smoothly, they have a solid team in place, did a nice job handling the end of semester buy-back process and had all refund checks distributed in less than a week. They are now finishing their final preparations for their first Glenbrook booksale.

At this time of year, the Board is provided a 3-year summary of the average price of textbooks sold during booksale. In previous years, it was estimated that 85% of students purchase textbooks at booksale as opposed to through the internet and other sources. Additionally, not including new textbook adoptions, it is estimated that 90% of this year's GBS textbooks are used and 85% of GBN textbooks are used (percentage is about 5% higher than last year). The difference between schools is due to more GBS students returning books than GBN students.

50% of the cost of textbooks is returned to students at buy-back time, unless the school discontinues the textbook. Less than 1% of textbooks were discontinued and not bought back in FY 11/12.
