## **Short Term Options**

Options for Securing Student Transportation Services for the 2017-2018 School Year

## Option 1: Accept Current Bid

- Award a 3-year Contract to First Student
- Option to Terminate Agreement by April 1st
- Daily Route Rate \$81.76 (Year 1)
- Hourly Charter Rate \$50.31 (Year 1)
- 3% Increase (Year 2)
- 3% Increase (Year 3)

#### Benefits

- Continuity of Service with Feeder School Districts in the Township
- Refreshed Fleet
- Price Stability for 3-5 years

#### Concerns

• 31% Overall Increase

## Option 2: Solicit New Bid

- Issue a New Bid Request for a 3-year Contract
- Option to Terminate Agreement by April 1st
- Relax the Average Age Requirement for the Fleet
  - No Older than 12 Years; Average Age of 7
  - CPS 10 years; D113 10 years;
     D211 10-12 years: No State Requirement
- Estimated Daily Route Rate \$62.00 \$95.00
- Estimated Hourly Charter Rate: \$50.31
- Estimated Bidders: First Student
- Estimated 3% Increase (Year 2)

#### **Benefits**

- Possibility to Lower Daily Route Rate
- Can be Solicited Prior to Rejecting Current Bid

#### Concerns

Potential for Rate Increase Greater than 31%

- Recruit and Retain Drivers
- Recruit and Retain Mechanics
- Recruit and Retain Administrator
- Build/Lease a Maintenance Facility
- Build/Lease a Bus Storage Lot

Highland Park/Deerfield 113 model

# Option 3: Partial In-House for Charter Services

- Purchase 2-4 Buses
- Recruit and Retain Drivers
- Potentially Establish a Stipend for a Scheduler / Liaison
- Establish Service with Local Provider

### Option 4: Review Route Options

- Transition to a "Loop" Model
- Public Transportation Options
