**RE:** Administrative Compensation Reporting Requirements (P.A. 96-0434)

On October 13, 2009, Governor Quinn signed into law P.A 96-0434, creating new salary reporting requirements for administrative employees. An itemized administrative compensation report must be submitted to the Board of Education for discussion at a regularly scheduled board meeting and posted on the district's website no later than October 1, 2012. The report must also be submitted to the North Cook Intermediate Service Center. The State has issued no formal guidelines relative to the structure or format of this report. It is required that this report be brought to the Board of Education prior to its posting, which will allow for time to execute any adjustments. P.A. 96-0434 also requires all collective bargaining agreements to be posted online, for which Glenbrook is already in compliance.

The Governor also signed into law P.A. 97-0256, which requires a similar compensation report for all teachers effective January 1, 2012. This report is pending an ISBE standard form, which may or may not affect the content and structure of the administrative compensation report as presented.
