## RE: DISCUSSION/ACTION: AWARD of BID: BAND UNIFORMS

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the purchase of marching band uniforms for Glenbrook North and Glenbrook South High Schools in the amount of \$198,061 from The Bandmans Co.

## Background

Marching band uniforms were last purchased in the spring of 2000 and are going on their $12^{\text {th }}$ year. Over the last 18 months, the band directors and a committee of band parents have been working on uniform design. During this period of time, they have gone through many iterations of sketches, reviewed various fabric selections and discussed color choices.

The uniforms selected by GBS have capes and gauntlet cuffs which are not part of the GBN uniform. This results in a slightly higher (approx 13\%) unit cost for the GBS uniforms.
