Each year in September the Board receives an update on Discretionary activities for their approval. I have received that information from each building for the 2010-11 school year.

#### **Comments:**

Dr. Tarjan reports that GBN has 2 new clubs for 2010-11. The Spartan Medical Club is designed to provide experiences in the medical field to students through visits to facilities, interaction with practitioners, and a review of literature in the field.

The Spoken Emotion Poetry Club will not only review poets and poetry, but will encourage students to write and share. Both clubs have been in existence for the past few years. This marks their entry as clubs on the official District list for remuneration to the sponsor.

Dr. Shellard indicated that GBS has initiated the Korean Club which is designed to be reflective of Korean culture and the issues that revolve around the Korean population in the Glenbrooks.

Current expenditures for 2010-11 are listed to date. As the Board can see in the spreadsheet for Item 6.8, a number of TBA or TBD notations are listed for both schools. I have included the allocation amounts for the Board to review. The building administration is responsible for monitoring and holding to the allocation within the building budget.

The Board will note that at least 15 students need to commit to an activity before it becomes an official listing in the building budget. New activities run for 3 years to monitor consistent student interest and involvement before the activity is officially listed on the discretionary list for sponsor remuneration.

I have enclosed Board Policy 8260 for Board review with this agenda item.

I recommend the Board approve the discretionary/club activities as presented for 2010-11.

#### I. Student Activities

#### Section A

Through their very nature, extra-class activities provide meaningful learning experiences found in no other area of the school and, thus, are an integral part of the total process of education. The values students gain through participation in clubs, organizations and activities supplement, complement and promote the academic life of the school. Students have the opportunity to develop new friendships, to lead and to follow, to develop leisure-time activities, to extend classroom interests, and to grow socially and emotionally. Student learn to know and appreciate the friendliness and guidance to be gained through adult contacts; they acquire a sense of belonging through identification with a small group within the school. Activities provide some area of responsible leadership for each student and encourage those with the capacity for outstanding leadership to use it constructively. Students learn how to evaluate and define good leadership and are helped to acquire their own personal code of conduct which determines and directs their behavior.

#### Section B

The Board of Education believes that the school should provide a wide variety of extra-curricular activities sponsored by the district. This section in no way implies that students shall be coerced, forced, or required to participate in any activity. Participation in activities shall be voluntary.

#### Section C

The Board of Education or its designated representatives shall approve all class organizations, clubs, associations, activities and the purposes of each.

#### Section D

Approval of new student organizations, clubs, associations, activities, and intramural or interscholastic athletic teams will be based upon the fulfillment of the following criteria:

- 1. Interest in activity has been shown by a sufficient number of students.
- 2. The function of the activity can best be performed by the Glenbrook High Schools rather than some other agency, public or private.
- 3. The objectives of the activity are in harmony with the philosophy of the Glenbrook High Schools.
- 4. The availability of a sponsor/coach who is interested and enthusiastic in the activity's primary function.
- 5. Overnight excursions are not imperative to the success of the activity.
- 6. Availability and approval of funding.

#### Section E

All student organizations, clubs, associations, and activities shall be subject to the administrative procedures set forth by the principal or his designated representatives in each school.

#### Section F

No student will be denied the protected right to membership in any school-chartered student organization because of his religion, race, creed, color, or economic status. Critical examination and the balanced presentation of differing views on controversial issues are encouraged. It is expected that student organizations will remain free from advocacy of religious, political, or ideological partisanship.

#### II. Eligibility

#### Section A

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education that all students who participate in any "schoolsponsored or school-supported athletic or extra curricular activity" (hereafter referred to as "activity") shall be in compliance with the Scholastic Standing provisions specified in the current Athletic Eligibility By-Laws promulgated by the Illinois High School Association (IHSA). A student who fails to meet the minimum standards for Scholastic Standing set forth in the IHSA Athletic Eligibility By-Laws shall be suspended from further participation in every activity until eligibility is reestablished in accordance with the IHSA Athletic Eligibility By-Laws.

#### Section B

The administration is directed to establish, implement and enforce procedures governing the administration of this policy and shall distribute copies of this policy and its related rules and procedures to all parents, students and staff members on an annual basis. The administration shall maintain records on the number and length of suspensions imposed under this policy.
