RE: REVIEW OF THE 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR CALENDAR; ESTABLISHMENT OF
THE SCHOOL YEAR CLOSING DATE

DATE: June 3, 2009

Included in our annual school year calendar are ten “emergency days” intended to be used if an emergency, usually weather related, compels us to close both of our schools and extend the school year. Each year the Board of Education is asked to revise the school calendar by deleting the unused emergency days and thereby establishing a new closing date. After the Board approval, we must file an official final school year calendar with the Regional Office of Education.

Attached you will find a copy of our current 2008-2009 school year calendar.

Due to inclement weather and unsafe driving conditions, Friday, December 19, 2008, was declared a snow day and school was cancelled. To make up for the missed day, one attendance day will be added to the calendar. Instead of school ending for students Wednesday, June 10 the last day of school will now be Thursday, June 11, 2009.

I recommend that the Board of Education approve the deletion of the extra emergency days from the 2008-2009 school year calendar, thus establishing Thursday, June 11, 2009 as the official last day of school for students and June 12, 2009 as the official last day of school for 10-month certified staff.
