## 2018-19 Non-Tenured Certified Staffing Recommendations:

- Approve the rehiring of *full-time* non-tenured certified staff members listed as such on the attached spreadsheet. Note that certified staff members being rehired after a fourth consecutive year of full-time employment will be granted tenure.
- Approve the retaining of *part-time* non-tenured certified staff members listed as such on the attached spreadsheet. These staff members will have the same or greater part-time FTE amounts.
- Adopt the **RESOLUTION FOR DISMISSAL AND REASSIGNMENT OF TEACHERS** to assign a *lesser amount* of teaching assignment to current *full-time* non-tenured certified staff members listed as such on the attached spreadsheet.
- Adopt the **RESOLUTION FOR RELEASE OF TEACHERS** to release the non-tenured certified staff members listed as such on the attached spreadsheet. These staff members are to be assigned **no FTE**.



Each staff list was prepared in consultation with the building principals and has received their approval.

Some of the certified staff members being dismissed or reduced at this time may be reemployed after more enrollment information is gathered and reviewed in the coming weeks.

Following the Board Meeting on March 19, 2018, certified staff members being released or reduced will meet with their building principals to receive the letter of release. In addition, the letter will be mailed home via certified mail.



We regret to advise you that the Board of Education of Northfield Township High School District No. 225, Cook County, Illinois, pursuant to Section 24-12 of the <u>School Code of Illinois</u>, has determined that you are to be honorably dismissed from full-time teaching employment effective as of the end of the 2017-2018 school term and reassigned to a part-time teaching position beginning with the 2018-2019 school term. The specific reason for your dismissal from full-time teaching is that it is uncertain whether there will be sufficient student enrollment for the 2018-2019 school term to necessitate your full-time employment.


