RE: DISCUSSION/ACTION: QUEST RENEWAL CONTRACT

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Education extend its contract with Quest Food Management Services for a new 5-year term, with the option to renew for an additional (5) 1-year terms. The current contract ends June 30, 2012 and has an option to renew for an additional (5) 1-year terms.

An early renewal is being requested as Quest has offered, in exchange for a contract extension, to fund the free/reduced breakfast program in an amount not to exceed \$15,000/year. Although not in our current contract, as a good faith effort, Quest is absorbing the cost of the current year breakfast program estimated at \$10,665.

## **BACKGROUND**

At the September 27, 2010 board meeting, the board approved offering a free and reduced breakfast program to students meeting federal eligibility requirements. The estimated cost of the program was \$9K-\$30K/year depending on overall participation. Since the breakfast program was implemented, an average of 47 meals/day was given to free students and 2 meals/day were sold to reduced students. This extrapolates to an annual cost of \$10,665.

All other terms of the contract would remain the same including Quest's responsibility for funding 100% of the free and reduced <u>lunch</u> program which is estimated to cost Quest \$113,000 this year. In addition, there is a clause in the current contract giving either party an "out" for the next school year with written notice on or before March 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.
