 Re: Substitute Teacher Compensation
 Date: June 25, 2014

Recommendation: It is recommended that the Board of Education approve an increase in the compensation rate of substitute teachers from \$90 to \$100 per day for the first 20 days and from \$98 to \$108 per day for 20 to 30 days beginning in the 2014 - 2015 school year.

Background

In early May, the building principals expressed concern that the pool of substitutes might be diminishing due to a difference in compensation rates in comparison to other area high school districts. This was based on feedback from the departments in their efforts to procure substitutes and their conversations with current substitutes working for the district. As a follow-up, I asked Dr. Caliendo to collect comparative rates from the surrounding high school districts, which revealed the following:

Based on the number of substitutes used during an average school year, Mrs. Siena has estimated that this recommendation will result in approximately a \$30,000 increase across the district. Procurement of substitute teachers is a district initiative for the Human Resources Department for the 2014 - 2015 school year. We will be working to expand the Skyward system to establish digital tracking of substitutes and will consider a third party application that will allow substitutes to be procured electronically.
