Attached you will find the list of textbook changes we are recommending for next year for Glenbrook North, Glenbrook South, and Glenbrook Academy of International Studies. The books dropped in Academy are related to the world language cycle shift from Mandarin to Spanish at the senior level.

The requests have been reviewed by the teachers involved, the instructional supervisors and the associate principals. All attached requests are recommended for approval. Copies of the proposed textbooks will be available at the Board meeting for review on Monday, April 12, 2010. Kris Frandson, associate principal at Glenbrook North and Cameron Muir, associate principal at Glenbrook South will be at the meeting to assist in addressing Board questions as will some of the instructional supervisors.

While this compilation reflects the majority of textbook changes, we may bring to the Board a limited number of texts in mid-summer, which reflect instructional decisions made during summer curriculum projects.

I recommend that the attached list be presented to the Board of Education for the Board's preliminary review at its meeting of April 12, 2010. It is my intention to resubmit the changes for Board approval at the regular Board meeting of April 26, 2010 on the consent agenda.

Attached you will find one document that summarizes the request for textbook adoptions for the 2010-2011 school year: *Textbook Change Summary 2010-2011*.

The GBN curriculum has continued to evolve through the Educational Planning Process, participation in articulation with sender schools, the availability of instructional technology components that accompany many new textbooks, student enrollment in courses that have not run in the past and in response to the GBN instructional goals of critical thinking, 21st century literacies, with a focus on reading, writing and math in the context of Response to Intervention (RtI). In light of these initiatives, come requests for changes in a number of textbooks in Foreign Language (7), Science (1), Social Studies (2) and Physical Education/Career and Life Skills (1). New Science elective courses (4) and new World Language offerings in Hebrew necessitated the adoption of a several new textbooks. The remaining textbooks proposed for adoption are due to publisher changes and availability of textbooks in English (1- writing manual) World Languages (4) Mathematics (5), and Social Studies (1).

Attached you will find one document that summarizes the request for textbook adoptions: *Textbook Change Summary 2010-2011*.

The curriculum at GBS continues to evolve through the Educational Planning Process, the AP Audit, articulation with sender districts, research in best practices, and the ever changing needs of our at-risk students. Along with these curricular changes, come requests for changes in a number of textbooks in English (8), Foreign Language (3), Mathematics (5), and Social Studies (3). New courses in Foreign Language (2) have also necessitated the adoption of new textbooks. The remainder of textbooks proposed for adoption is due to publisher changes, outdated information, and availability of textbooks in ELL(2), Science (2), and Social Studies (2).
