## **Background**

Due to the construction work and heavy vibration in the area of the existing pool, the District requested that an independent tile consultant come out and look at the status of the existing tile in the pool basin. The consultant recommended that the pool basin be regrouted and all loose tiles be replaced. Two quotes were received for this work, one from Lowery Tile in the amount of \$39,000 and the other from Trostrud Tile in the amount of \$42,000.
